

2018 COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS INFORMATION

IMPORTANT INFORMATION/RULES FOR SPECTATORS AND SWIMMERS:

1. CLUB OPENING/MEET TIMES

- NO ARRIVALS before 6:30am. There are neighborhood restrictions on the use times of Roxbury being enforced. Please respect this.
- The gate will be locked until 6:30am. Do not show up before and expect to get in.
- Warm-ups begin at 7am and meet will start at 8:30am. These times are new this year.

2. PARKING

- All parking will be in the Westhill High School parking lot. The address is 125 Roxbury Road.
- **There will be NO swimmer drop off at Roxbury.**
- Everyone will proceed **directly** to the Westhill parking lot and walk to Roxbury.
- Any individuals requiring handicapped **drop off** please email Scott Bounty, Roxbury general manager at Pool@Roxburyclub.com in advance by Thursday, August 9th at 5pm to make arrangements to drop off individuals at Roxbury before parking at Westhill.
- If handicapped **parking** is required, there will be limited parking at Roxbury. All arrangements must be made in advance by August 9th with Mr. Bounty. Once handicapped limited spots are filled no more requests will be able to be accommodated. No requests will be accepted after 8/9/18.
- There is absolutely NO PARKING on Roxbury Road or the neighborhood across the street. The police will ticket and/or tow you.
- There will be two Stamford Police Officers and Roxbury personnel enforcing these rules at the entrance to the club.

3. MEET INFORMATION

- Swimmers are to provide their own chairs (no chaise lounges will be available on deck for swimmers).
- Be prepared for the weather. If hot, bring extra water. If cold, extra clothing. We will swim the meet even if raining.
- Metro Swim Shop will be selling FCSL custom logo apparel, swimsuits, goggles, caps etc.
- Jolyn Clothing will be selling swimsuits and apparel.

4. FOOD/DRINK

- Drinks need to be in spill proof containers.
- No ice cream on deck.
- Swimmers should bring food that does not leave crumbs or gooey messes on deck.
- Snack bar will be serving a limited menu and will be cash only (no club charge backs).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION/RULES FOR SPECTATORS AND SWIMMERS:

5. MANDATORY MEET VOLUNTEERS

- Each club is expected to provide the volunteers your club is assigned.
- All volunteers must check in at the volunteer sign in table by 7:45am. Coaches will be informed at 8:00am if their team volunteers have not signed in.
- If your team's volunteers have not signed in and shown up, the meet will not start. Make sure your teams assignments are filled.
- Each club must assign a designated clean up volunteer. This person is responsible for making sure that your team area is exactly as your team found it when they arrived in the morning.
- The clean up volunteer also needs to pick up the awards at the end of the meet. NO awards will be held at Roxbury or brought home by the FCSL officers. You bring them with you or they are thrown out. Your kids will not get replacements. It is your teams responsibly to bring them home at the meets conclusion.
- The name of the clean up volunteer must be provided by 5:00pm on 8/10/18.

6. MEET MARSHALLS/WHO IS ALLOWED ON DECK

- ONLY SWIMMERS, COACHES AND VOLUNTEERS WITH BADGES WILL BE ALLOWED ON DECK.
- Meet marshalls are responsible for allowing/refusing entry to the pool deck and enforcing meet rules. Respect FOR the meet marshalls is mandatory.
- Absolutely NO spectators/parents will be allowed on the pool deck.
- Parents/Spectators are to be courteous to others.
- If you child is not racing in the heat, allow another parent whose child is to view.
- If these rules are not followed and you are not respectful to Officials/Marshalls etc you will be escorted from the meet/premises by police.

These rules are in place for the safety of all the participants and for the respect of the facility. Anyone not following any of these rules will be removed from the meet by the police.
