

2018 COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS INFORMATION

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR COACHES:

1. Banner/Tent drop off:

- Coaches may drop off tents and banners from 6pm to 7:30pm **ONLY** on Friday, August 10th, or you may bring it the day of the meet starting at 6:30am.
- There will be **NO** set up of tents or hanging of banners the night before. All set up is to be done Saturday morning upon arrival.

2. Parking:

- Spaces at Roxbury will be limited and by parking pass only.
- Parking will be only in the lower lot by the pool, no parking up by the tennis courts. Tennis players will have a different color pass. If you are parked up there with wrong pass you are subject to be ticketed or towed.
- Parking passes will be distributed by Rick Lewis.
- Parking passes must be displayed at all times during the meet on your windshield. Cars without displayed parking passes are subject to ticketing or towing.
- A pass does not guarantee you a space; once lot is full you will be directed to the Westhill High School Parking lot.

3. Club Opening/Meet times

- No arrivals of coaches or parents before 6:30am. There are neighborhood restrictions on the use times of Roxbury being enforced. Please respect this.
- The gate will be locked until 6:30am. Do not show up before and expect to get in.
- Warm-ups begin at 7am and meet will start at 8:30am. These times are new this year.

4. Meet Volunteers

- Each club is expected to provide the volunteers your club is assigned.
- If your team's volunteers have not signed in, you as a coach will be expected to go off deck and find a parent to fulfill the role or the meet will not start.
- Each club must assign a designated clean up volunteer. This person is responsible for making sure that your team area is exactly as you found it when you arrived in the morning. Plastic garbage bags will be provided. **THE NAME OF THIS VOLUNTEER NEEDS TO BE EMAILED TO MARIA BREA BY FRIDAY, AUGUST 10TH AT NOON (mariabrea@optonline.net).**
- If the designated clean up volunteer does not show up at the end of the meet, this job will default to the coaching staff.
- The clean up volunteer or coach also needs to pick up the awards at the end of the meet. **NO** awards will be held at Roxbury or brought home by the FCSL officers. You bring them with you or they are thrown out.

5. FOOD/DRINK

- Drinks need to be in spill proof containers.
- No ice cream on deck.
- Bring food that does not leave crumbs or gooey messes.
- Snack bar will be serving a limited menu and will be cash only (no club charge backs).
- There will be coach's hospitality provided.
